

## **Gramercy Park Update**

### **July 24, 2008**

The Bartlett Tree experts who were scheduled to service the Park trees this morning will not be coming today because of the rain. They are now scheduled to work tomorrow (Friday) July 25th and next Friday, August 1st. They will arrive at approximately 9:00 am and leave around 4:00 pm. For your safety, the Park will be closed during those times, on both of those days.

I just received word from the Department of Transportation Manhattan Borough Commissioner Margaret Forgione, that the work crew scheduled to remove the parking meters around Gramercy Park will be here working Monday, July 28th through Wednesday, July 30th. Their estimated arrival time is 7:30 am, at which time a special dye will be added to cement to match the sidewalk color and fill the hole. I've been told that the cement will dry to a lighter color. ### **July 31, 2008**

Last Friday the Bartlett Tree Experts, the company that does the annual pruning of our Park trees, checked and pruned the trees whose branches were overhanging the Park fence. They climbed the trees to check their stability and remove dead limbs and branches to allow more sun in to keep the trees healthy. They also checked and pruned the trees in the east section of the Park

Tomorrow (Friday) weather permitting, they will check and prune the trees in the rest of the Park. For your safety, the Park will be closed from 9:00 am until 6:00 pm.
